1		E2 Benrinnes, 1997 – 23 Years Old Speyside Single Malt – 56,9% (Bourbon Hogshead) Nose: Notes of white pepper, vanilla, oranges and caramel. Palate: The palate is dominated by notes of sweet milk chocolate and lovely vanilla. It's a spicy and fruity dram with hint white pepper. Finish: The aftertaste is very long with long-lasting pepper, vanilla, green fruits and spice. A sweet ending that is long and intense.	
2		F8 Auchroisk, 1996 – 24 Years Old Speyside Single Malt – 48,4% (Bourbon Hogshead) Nose: Notes of oak, peaches, toffee, vanilla and very nutty. Like walking into a ware house. Palate: The taste is extremely delicate, soft and with notes of nuts, sweet vanilla and soft oak aromas. A really well developed and balanced taste. Call it old-fashioned. That's what it is! Finish: The finish is intense, long and tasty with notes of black pepper, raisins and oak. Warming and spicy at the very end. It's an excellent dram.	
3		B2 Jura, 1997 – 23 Years Old Island Single Malt – 53,7% (Bourbon Barrel) Nose: Notes of vanilla, fudge caramel and biscuits. Palate: The palate is fat and oily and dominated by notes of barley, caramel, toffee and at bit of menthol and salt. It's very complex. Finish: A very nice long finish, with sweet oak and a spicy note.	
4		E1 Dufftown, 1991 – 29 Years Old Speyside Single Malt – 52,6% (Bourbon Barrel) Nose: Notes of grass, straw and mint with vanilla. Palate: A very light and gentle beginning. Then hints of citrus with green apples and melon takes over and lots of vanilla is coming through. It's a very aromatic with wood and honey note. A very gentle and (almost to) easy drinking dram. Finish: A medium long finish, with sweet and spicy notes of oak and white pepper.	
5		D7 Glenburgie, 1998 – 23 Years Old Speyside Single Malt – 54,0% (Refill Hogshead) Nose: Notes of butterscotch, mango, cinnamon, oranges, passion fruit and pineapples. Palate: This nice dram has a taste of nuts/almonds and it's getting toasted in the taste with notes of jam, marzipan and apricots. Very fat and oily. Finish: The finish is nice and long and creamy/oily with lots of fruit.	
6		B1 Inchgower, 1998 – 23 Years Old Speyside Single Malt – 57,5% (Refill Hogshead) Nose: Notes of charred oak, spices, fruits and barley. Palate: What a nice creamy taste with lots of honey, nuts, ginger and creamy vanilla ice cream. Finish: A very long lasting freshly after taste with notes of oat biscuits, pears and fresh green fruitsweetness, spices and a hint of toffee and grapefruit notes. It's a cracking sherried Highland malt.	
7		LAGG Inaugural Batch 2 – Oloroso Firkins 50% Nose: Medium intensity. Earthy peat smoke. Lots of sweetness and nuttiness coming through. Cocoa, some fruitcake. A real earthy note. Palate: Creamy and thick. Big hit of the peat. Certainly, doesn't feel its ABV! Some chewy toffees and red fruits. Finish: Medium-Long. More peat, classic bonfires. Oaked tannins and a hint of sweetness. Touches of salted caramel and caramelised sugars.	
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
